

APPROVED**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
NORTH ORANGE COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT**

June 12, 2007

The Board of Trustees of the North Orange County Community College District met for its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, June 12, 2007, at 5:30 p.m. at the Board Room at the Anaheim Campus.

President Jeff Brown called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

COMMENTS: MEMBERS OF THE AUDIENCE:

A. **James Kiefer** from Fullerton College submitted the following statement for the record:

1. Physical Education Curriculum and the Curriculum Process.

The state of California places the responsibility for curriculum in the hands of faculty. Fullerton College faculty spent three years developing a common document describing criteria for suggested class sizes for persons developing or upgrading curriculum. This document was shared with Cypress College, redone, and shared again across the disciplines to come up with a way to create uniformity based on sound educational rationales. This was the document utilized by Fullerton College's Physical Education faculty in order to conform with the District's direction.

At issue: During FC's Physical Education six-year review, faculty was asked to go over and update established curriculum and to comply with the direction coming from the faculty curriculum committee. This was done. When this substantial job was done, it went to the curriculum committee for scrutiny. It was approved. The president of Fullerton College asked faculty in physical education to "take a look at it one more time and to get consensus with Cypress College's Physical Education Division." We did and we gained consensus with the possible exception of the understanding of implementation of the Carnegie Unit. It went back to the curriculum committee and with due diligence the committee supported PE curriculum once again. The president of Fullerton College found Physical Education's curriculum to be unacceptable (based, I assume, primarily because of class size), but stated that we "could agree to disagree" and that she would not stand in the way of state and district process. And now we are here. To this date, we have had no direction from the President as to what a plausible class size number would be or "what it would look like". The number we selected is in accordance when compared with many of the community colleges in our area, and it meets the test of sound pedagogy. When all of the factors of analysis are applied, safety, communication, student learning and cost, the efforts of the faculty in physical education seem to have been diligent and educationally responsible.

2. The NOCCCD's Commitment to Physical Education for its constituency.

NOCCCD sought Measure X and marketed as a major part of it the renovation of Physical Education Facilities at Fullerton College. It established a twenty-six million dollar commitment for these projects. Given that fact, it seems fair to postulate that physical education is an important part of the district core values and mission.

3. The Fullerton College physical education requirement for its students.

Given the district's commitment to Physical Education at Fullerton College and the other segments of the district, and given the information that has been disseminated from all established medical corners, it is contradictory to offer a one unit graduation requirement for the students we serve. We mandate opportunity in other disciplines. There are many examples. It is arguable, however, that there is no discipline that can

have such a positive effect on one's whole self as is the case for physical education. In the present and in the future, social institutions are going to have to face responsibility for providing mandated learning and activity opportunities for all people to learn and to practice positive health lifestyles. In the future, American Society cannot afford to simply disregard the reality of a weakened physicality of its youth. The cost in dollars and in palpable misery is irrefutable.

Motion carried unanimously.

COMMENTS:

- A. **Rod Lusch** thanked the Chancellor and others who attended the recent CSEA Luncheon.
- B. **Trustee Michael Matsuda** inquired on what the policy is for commencement ceremonies regarding graduates wearing sashes at commencement. Chancellor Hunter responded that no such policy exists and the college presidents outlined what their respective campus practices are, including the approval process for the wearing of sashes/medallions. Mr. Matsuda reminded everyone that commencement is a true celebration of accomplishment and is willing to work with the colleges to establish a more inclusive practice.
- C. **Trustee Manny Ontiveros** reported on the recent Board Audit Committee meeting and its discussion regarding the possibility of hiring an internal auditor working for the Board/District.
- D. **Trustee Leonard Lahtinen** commended the colleges on their respective commencement ceremonies and the Fullerton College Athletic Hall of Fame event.
- E. **Trustee Molly McClanahan** echoed Mr. Lahtinen's sentiments regarding the Hall of Fame event.
- F. **Board President Jeff Brown** announced that the Board received a Certificate of Commendation from the Fullerton College Associated Students.
- G. **Andrea Sibley-Smith** thanked Trustee Leonard Lahtinen for his attendance at the SCE Classified Luncheon.

MINUTES: It was moved by Trustee Leonard Lahtinen and seconded by Trustee Molly McClanahan that the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of May 22, 2007, be approved as submitted. **Motion carried unanimously, including the Student Trustee's advisory vote.**

FINANCE & FACILITIES:

Item 3.a: Upon a brief discussion on a purchase order and the handling of hazardous waste materials, it was moved by Trustee Leonard Lahtinen and seconded by Trustee Manny Ontiveros that the Board ratify purchase order numbers P0047110 through P0049131 through May 15, 2007, totaling \$3,061,734.29, and check numbers C0018565 through C0018855, totaling \$1,574,402.92; check numbers F0101512 through F0101968, totaling \$4,140,930.27; check numbers 88265217 through 88267298, totaling \$11,663,718.88; check numbers 70014538 through 70014782, totaling \$23,000.50; and check numbers V0030599 through V0030610, totaling \$14,412.27; and disbursements E8267231 through E8267244, totaling \$5,157.25, all from May 1 through 31, 2007. **Motion carried unanimously, including the Student Trustee's advisory vote.**

Item 3.b: By the block vote, the Board adopted a resolution, authorizing the County Superintendent of Schools to make any necessary transfers between contingencies and expenditure classifications.

Item 3.c: By the block vote, the Board authorized the 2006-07 General Fund, Bond Fund, and Capital Outlay Fund Budget Transfers netting to the amount of \$10,242,760 and adoption of the resolutions showing the summary, pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, Title 5, §58307.

Item 3.d: By the block vote, the Board authorized the Institutional Memberships exceeding \$1,000 for the 2007-08 school year.

Item 3.e: By the block vote, the Board authorized the disposal of Class 3 Disposable Records after July 1, 2007, from the District's Business Office, and the respective Bursar's Office of Cypress and Fullerton colleges and School of Continuing Education pursuant to Title 5, §59020 of the California Administrative Code.

Item 3.f: By the block vote, authorization was granted to award quotation TP53869, Spray Booth Equipment for Cypress College, to Mon Dragon Spray Booth, Inc., in the amount of \$58,128.32, plus tax and shipping.

Further authorization was granted for the District Director, Purchasing, to execute the contract on behalf of the District.

Item 3.g: By the block vote, the Board awarded Bid 2007-16, Point of Sale and Inventory Management System for Fullerton College Bookstore, to Ratex Business Solutions to provide a turnkey, fully integrated system, including software, hardware, training, installation, maintenance, and implementation support in the amount of \$244,683, plus tax and shipping.

Further authorization was granted for the District Director, Purchasing, to execute the contract on behalf of the District.

Item 3.h: By the block vote, the Board awarded a five-year contract which provides for annual price adjustments, upward or downward, as indicated in the Consumer Price Index for the Los Angeles/Long Beach area, to be awarded to Transportation Charter Services, Inc., in accordance with Bid 2007-19, Student Transportation, and the following fee schedule:

If overnight service is required, the additional cost will be \$120 per bus.

School bus cancellation with less than three (3) hours notice before the scheduled departure time will result in a charge of \$430 per bus.

Recliner bus cancellation with less than (3) hours notice before the scheduled departure time will result in a charge of \$575 per bus.

Further authorization was granted for the District Director, Purchasing, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.

Item 3.i: Upon clarification on 1) the possible resubmittal of an Initial Project Proposal, 2) the campus decision to not proceed with a Final Project Proposal, 3) Campus Site Restoration project, 4) the Berkeley Center Renovation project, and 5) the East Parking Structure project, it was moved by Trustee Leonard Lahtinen and seconded by Trustee Donna Miller that the Board accept the North Orange County Community College District's 2009/10-2013/14 Five Year Construction Plan, 2009/10 First State Funding Year, prepared and submitted in compliance with California Education Code §81800, et. al., and the California Community Colleges System Office directives to meet the submittal deadline of July 1, 2007. **The motion carried unanimously, including the Student Trustee's advisory vote.**

The Board further adopted Resolution No. 06/07-08, Approval of One Final Project Proposal for 2009/10 Fiscal Funding Year for the Cypress College Fine Arts Building 2 & Lecture Hall Renovation.

Additional authorization was granted to submit the proposal to the California Community Colleges System Office, and to certify the Approval Page for that FPP.

Item 3.j: Upon clarification on the temporary structure elimination project, it was moved by Trustee Leonard Lahtinen and seconded by Trustee Barbara Dunsheath that the Board grant authorization to amend the list of architectural firms for the Bond and State Capital Outlay funded projects, which was previously approved by the Board on June 11, 2002, and extend the respective agreements based on the current status of the projects. **The motion carried unanimously, including the Student Trustee's advisory vote.**

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to negotiate and to execute each agreement on behalf of the District.

Item 3.k: By the block vote, the Board authorized the amendment to the consulting agreement with Salas O'Brien Engineers, Inc. and increased the contract amount by \$23,650. The revised contract amount is \$71,218.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute the amendment on behalf of the District.

Item 3.l: By the block vote, authorization was granted to file the Notice of Completion of Work for PW 0304-401, Cypress College Library/Learning Resource Center, with Al Shankle Construction (BP#2, General Construction) and to release the final retention payment when due.

Item 3.m: By the block vote, the Board ratified the current change orders for the public works projects listed per the Change Order Request, with a total of \$128,895.37.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute each contractor agreement on behalf of the District.

Item 3.n: By the block vote, the Board entered into architectural agreements with LPA, Inc., contingent upon approval by the Office of the State Chancellor of the preliminary drawings for the Cypress College Humanities Building as follows:

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute the agreements on behalf on the District.

Item 3.o: The following individuals addressed the Board regarding the architectural agreement for the Fullerton College South Science Building 400 Replacement project:

- A. **Ben Crowell**, from Fullerton College, distributed a chronology of faculty votes against the proposed Fullerton College Science Building project. He expressed his concern for the unavailability of information and he is opposed to the project both as a faculty member and as a taxpayer.

- B. **Janice Chadwick**, from Fullerton College, submitted the following statement for the record:

Good evening,

My name is Janice Chadwick and I am a Professor of Chemistry at Fullerton College, a Faculty Senator for the Natural Science Division, and have intermittently been part of the Building Users Group (BUG) since its inception. I would like to speak about the agenda item concerning the vote to move forward with construction documents on the Natural Sciences replacement building at Fullerton College.

As part of the division, I can testify to the fact that faculty and staff have spent many hours discussing options, meeting with architects, and simply losing sleep over several aspects associated with the replacement building. I would like to remind you that these discussions have been going on for many years and the frustrations we have had in the past have an additive affect. Being a scientist, I would have to say that in this year, if I were to graph our concerns and frustrations, albeit anecdotally, the graph would include an exponential factor. With some reservations, I am happy to see progress in the design stage with the architects. However, I would like to share some concerns with you regarding timetables and cost overruns.

I walk around and enjoy our campus almost every day. From Natural Sciences, I look northwest to the beautiful Library Building, see a great Office and Classroom Building under construction to the north, and the beginnings of a Student Center south of us. I can't help but wonder if we will receive a building of the same quality and caliber as each of these. Science buildings have very special needs and so naturally, cost more. There seems to be a budget for the science building, but I continue to hear that the District will need to allocate additional funds to make this building of the same caliber as the other buildings now under construction. Then I walk behind the Natural Science Building and see the Physical Education Building. I know there were funds to replace or renovate this building, yet I see nothing has been done. Since I am on campus nearly every day of the week and see this juxtaposition. I wonder, what will happen to the Natural Science Building? Hopefully, you can see why faculty and staff are concerned about the outcome of the replacement of the Natural Science Building.

To sum up, I hope that in your decision this evening that you consider the following:

- 1) The faculty voted no to move forward with this building. This vote stands until we have an opportunity to vote again.

- 2) Faculty Senate voted to support the Natural Science Division No vote. That vote stands until we have an opportunity to vote again.
- 3) The cost overruns and timetables have not been fully addressed. Can this building be built in the timeframe suggested with the same quality as past and future buildings?

C. **Jacob Sapiro** from Fullerton College submitted the following statement for the record:

First, I would like to thank the Board for its interest in this project. Your involvement has been a very positive influence.

When I spoke to you in January about funding this project, we were talking in hypotheticals. Today we have a reasonable preliminary cost estimate, which is \$45 million. This includes swing space, furnishings, and takes into account inflation and the potential for some cost overruns. That means that about \$15 million will have to come from the District coffers, though a little of it can be offset by Measure X bond money. Again, I would like to remind you that this cost estimate is for a minimal building and is in line with estimates we were given three years ago by the architects who wrote the FPP. Any cuts to the instructional spaces would mean a cut in programs.

The Board is now faced with a choice. Do you commit to this project or not? There is no point in spending over \$1 million for construction documents if you are not willing to ultimately complete this project.

If you choose to go ahead, keep in mind that the Division voted NO based on the fact that a lot of crucial information was denied us when we took the vote. The preliminary plans submitted to us after the vote look promising. In August, when the Division reconvenes, we will have the construction documents to vote on. You need to trust us, as we trust you, to make the right decision once we see the construction documents and we have some assurances that they reflect the building which will actually be built.

Thank you.

D. **Ron Beeler** provided the Board with a brief history on the development of the District Master Plan in 1999, which included the Fullerton College Science Building, and the inception and current status of the Fullerton College Science Building project.

Etienne Runge and Lucian Runge of R2A Architecture conducted a presentation on the Fullerton College Science Building Replacement Project. Also included in the presentation was Vice Chancellor Fred Williams' cost estimate information for this construction project.

(See Supplemental Minutes #984 for a copy of the presentation.)

Upon conclusion of a lengthy and detailed question and answer session regarding the information presented and the Fullerton College faculty concerns, it was moved by Trustee Leonard Lahtinen and seconded by Trustee Donna Miller that the Board enter into architectural agreements with R2A Architecture, contingent upon approval by the Office of the State Chancellor of the construction drawings for the Fullerton College South Science Building 400 Replacement as follows:

The motion passed with Trustees Brown, Dunsheath, Lahtinen, McClanahan, and Miller voting yes and Trustee Matsuda and Ontiveros voting no.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute the agreements on behalf on the District.

Item 3.p: By the block vote, the Board authorized payment for the FUSION annual license fee in the amount of \$31,008.43 for the period of July 1, 2007, through June 30, 2008.

Further authorization was granted for the District Director, Purchasing, to execute the contract on behalf of the District.

Item 3.q: By the block vote, the Board authorized the amendment to the agreement with Pearson Government Solutions to reflect the name change to Vangent, Inc.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.

Item 3.r: By the block vote, the Board authorized retroactive approval of an agreement with Hampton Tedder Technical Services for maintenance services to be conducted on the Anaheim Campus electrical system for the period of May 1, 2007, through September 30, 2007, in the amount of \$31,526.

Further authorization was granted for the District Director, Purchasing, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.

Item 3.s: It was moved by Trustee Donna Miller and seconded by Trustee Barbara Dunsheath that the Board amend the agreement with C. W. Driver to extend the agreement retroactive to May 15, 2007, through June 30, 2008, in order to complete the College Center, Classroom Office Building, Wilshire School of Continuing Education, ACCO Chilled Water Project, Replacement of the 300 Stairs, Tunnel Hatch, Phase III Fire Alarm, Theater Rigging, Tennis Courts, and Pool Project. Fees for the extended agreement will not exceed \$1,979,446 that was previously owed. **The motion carried unanimously, including the Student Trustee's advisory vote.**

Further authorization was granted to reimburse C. W. Driver for expenses needed to the above-listed projects not to exceed \$60,000.

Additional authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.

Item 3.t: By the block vote, authorization was granted to enter into an agreement with Southern California Risk Management Associates, Inc. for claims administration services in the amount of \$71,423.92, and to enter into an agreement with ACE American Insurance Company through Arthur J. Gallagher & Co. for Fiscal Year 2007-08 for excess Workers' Compensation insurance coverage for the estimated amount of \$206,607; actual cost will be based on actual payroll cost.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute the contracts on behalf of the District.

Item 3.u: By the block vote, authorization was granted to renew the property and liability insurance coverage with the Alliance of Schools for Cooperative Insurance Programs (ASCIP) and Schools Excess Liability Fund (SELF) for FY2007-08 at the estimated amount of \$800,656.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute the contracts on behalf of the District.

Item 3.v: By the block vote, authorization was granted for Fullerton College to renew its license for the Blackboard Learning Systems Campus Edition 6.0 to support its Distance Education Program. The license will be renewed with Blackboard, Inc. for the period of July 20, 2007, through July 19, 2008, at a cost not to exceed \$29,200.

Further authorization was also granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.

INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES:

Item 4.a: By the block vote, the Board approved the School of Continuing Education summary of curriculum additions, to be effective in the summer 2007 trimester.

(See Supplemental Minutes #984 for a copy of the curriculum summary.)

Item 4.b: By the block vote, the Board authorized the Cypress College Staff Development to expend \$85,000 allocated from college funds, state Faculty and Staff Professional Development funds, the remaining Technology Training Infrastructure Program (TTIP) funds, monies from fund-raising events, and Title V funds for our comprehensive annual program for the academic year 2007-2008, which may include, but not be limited to, the following specific activities:

- \$30,000 to fund off-campus travel and conference attendance for faculty, managers, and classified staff, allocated through the Staff Development Conference Funding Request process.
- \$3,000 for new faculty and new classified staff orientation programs, including subscription to www.4faculty.org.
- \$7,000 for fall and spring Opening Day events, the Classified Appreciation Luncheon, and the end-of-the-year employee recognition event.
- \$45,000 for professional development events, such as brain-based research workshops; measurable student learning outcomes development workshop series; workshops on crucial conversations; cross-cultural awareness workshops; all-campus strategic planning colloquium; great teaching seminar; Hire Me! Workshops; and technology training workshops.

Related costs may include but are not limited to supplies, meals, lodging, conference registration and other expenses, promotional activities, contracted services training materials, recognition awards, consultants, professional experts, and reassigned time. Independent contractor agreements will be provided for Board approval at appropriate times.

Further authorization was granted for the Cypress College President to execute all contracts, including, but not limited to, group booking contracts and agreements, and independent contractor agreements on behalf of the District.

Item 4.c: By the block vote, the Board approved the Cypress College summary of curriculum additions and revision, to be effective fall 2008.

(See Supplemental Minutes #984 for a copy of the curriculum summary.)

Item 4.d: Upon discussion regarding the numerous reductions to class size, as well as with faculty contract language regarding class size, it was moved by Trustee Donna Miller and seconded by Trustee Molly McClanahan that the Board table this item and the issue be directed back to the Chancellor. Upon further discussion, the motion was withdrawn.

Trustee Leonard Lahtinen then moved and Trustee Barbara Dunsheath seconded to approve the recommendation for the Fullerton College summary of curriculum additions, deletions, and changes, to be effective fall 2008. Considerable discussion ensued with a number of trustees expressing concern with the curriculum approval process and the role of the college president in that process, as well as with class size reductions (working conditions) and whether they should be addressed as part of the curriculum process or through contract negotiations. During discussion, Fullerton physical education faculty members provided additional information regarding the six-year review process followed, the agreed-upon class size guidelines, and concerns about delaying approval of the changes, proposed to be effective fall 2008. A number of trustees expressed their need for additional information and clarification regarding what the college president's responsibility is related to curriculum and what the president's signature means, as well as what it means to be economically feasible.

In concluding a lengthy and detailed discussion on this item, it was moved by Trustee Donna Miller and seconded by Trustee Molly McClanahan to table this item to a time to be determined by the Chancellor when he has obtained clarification on the role of the college president in the curriculum approval process, equity issues within the District, best practices, and contractual issues. **The motion carried with Trustees Brown, Dunsheath, McClanahan, Miller, and Ontiveros voting yes and Trustees Lahtinen and Matsuda voting no.**

Item 4.e: By the block vote, the Board approved the following donations to Fullerton College:

- For the Printing Program: Five-5 pound cans of ink from Gans Ink of Anaheim, CA.
- For the Printing Program: \$1,000 cash donation from Printing Industries Association of Southern California.
- For the Radio Program: Marti Cellcast remote broadcast unit and carry case, Telex V220 broadcast headset and TM Century Ultimate Digital Studio software from Bob Rivkin of Palm Springs, CA.
