

APPROVED**MINUTES OF THE ONLY REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
NORTH ORANGE COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT**

July 28, 2009

The Board of Trustees of the North Orange County Community College District met for its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, June 28, 2009, at 5:30 p.m. in the Anaheim Campus Board Room.

Board President Leonard Lahtinen called the meeting to order at 5:33 p.m. and Barbara Dunsheath led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

COMMENTS: MEMBERS OF THE AUDIENCE:

- A. **Sam Russo** submitted a statement for the record expressing ADFAC's concern regarding the methods the District will follow in successfully dealing with the budget cuts. He urged the Board to work together with all employees "...to share the pain of the current bad times..." and not allow part-time faculty layoffs to be the main source of the budget reduction.

- B. **Mary Frances Gable** addressed the Board regarding the positive negotiations among the College District, the City of Fullerton, and the Fullerton Joint Union High School District regarding the Fullerton High School stadium. She urged the Board to continue on this path.

Motion carried, including Student Trustee Cindy Garcia’s advisory vote of yes and Student Trustee Rajan Vaidya’s advisory vote of no on item 5.a.

REPORTS

- A. **Chancellor Ned Doffoney** reported on his participation in a conference call earlier in the day with the Governor’s staff to review the latest budget impact on the District. He also called the Board’s attention to the 2009 Community Report and commended the District Public Affairs Office for the excellent document. Dr. Doffoney announced that Chancellor’s Staff will be conducting interviews of the three firms that are finalists being considered as the District’s Educational Master Plan consultant. He added that a recommendation will be forwarded to the Board in the near future. In addition, Dr. Doffoney reported he will be out of the office the week of August 3 as he will be attending the American Association of Community Colleges Summer Board Retreat, of which he is a member.

Chancellor Doffoney requested the Board’s suggestions for a Taxpayer Representative to the Bond Citizens’ Oversight Committee and suggestions for a Trustee and Community Representative to the Orange County Community Colleges Legislative Task Force, which Chancellor Doffoney will chair during the 2009-10 academic year.

- B. **Vice Chancellor Fred Williams** provided an update on the State Budget and its impact on the District. The Governor approved the State Budget earlier in the day and Mr. Williams reported that more cuts for the state’s community colleges, as well as fee increases for students during 2009-10 were included in the signed budget. The District will begin collecting the higher student fees immediately as class enrollment continues for fall term at Cypress and Fullerton colleges. The fee, which increases from \$20 to \$26 per unit by action of the State Legislature, goes into effect retroactively for those students who already have enrolled. Mr. Williams identified the following impact to NOCCCD as a result of the signed State Budget: 1) \$7 million+ reductions to categorical programs; 2) \$4.65 million reduction to the base allocation;

3) \$1.5 million in property tax shortfall; 4) student fee shortfall of \$599,000; 5) and categorical funding flexibility at the local level. He added that an \$85 million General Purpose Reduction for 2008-09 was not enacted – but was shifted to the K-12 system. Additional deferrals include 1) using next year's revenue to balance the current year's budget; 2) moved expenditures to future years; and 3) the community colleges can expect mid-year 2009-10 cuts and additional budget reductions for 2010-2011.

In response to Board inquiries, Mr. Williams responded that the facility/construction funds are separate from the general funds and are not directly impacted at the present time. As for class offerings, Mr. Williams explained that the District served 3,800 more students than it was funded for last year. In the NOCCCD, he said, “we are fulfilling our obligation” to serve the number of students for whom we are receiving funding to serve. He added that the Tentative Budget included two areas of significant reduction: 1) vacant positions (full-time faculty, classified, and management) for about a \$7 million savings, and 2) workload measures were implemented and class offerings were reduced by the colleges in order to stay within the budget provided by the state.

- C. **Christine Terry**, Provost of the School of Continuing Education; **Mike Kasler**, Cypress College President; and **Kathie Hodge**, Fullerton College President, reported on activities from their respective areas.

- A. **Fola Odebunmi** reported on her participation with the CTA at the state level and announced that 700 academic employees have been making calls to legislators regarding the State Budget.
- B. **Sam Russo** announced that September 11 is the ADFAC's annual back-to-school party.
- C. **Rod Lusch** reported on his internship with the state CSEA and thanked Chapter 167's executive board for a job well done in his absence.
- D. **Student Trustee Cindy Garcia** reported on Cypress College campus activities. She specifically noted the increased enrollment for fall 2009.
- E. **Student Trustee RajaN Vaidya** reported on Fullerton College campus activities.
- F. **Trustee Donna Miller** commended the District Public Affairs Office on the District's 2009 Community Report.

- G. **Trustee Michael Matsuda** requested a future report on construction projects and where cuts are being made to such projects.
- H. **Trustee Molly McClanahan** read a comment from Eric Green in which he commended the Fullerton College Choir's performance in central California.
- I. **Trustee Barbara Dunsheath** noted an article regarding the Accrediting Commission for Community & Junior College's sanctions against California community colleges and an article from the *Chronicle of Higher Education* regarding "What is Shared Governance."
- J. **Trustee Leonard Lahtinen** commented on the recent evaluation of legal services provided to the District and noted that four firms are retained for various categories of legal services provided the District.

MINUTES: It was moved by Trustee Jeff Brown and seconded by Trustee Molly McClanahan that the Board approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of June 23, 2009, as submitted. **Motion carried, including the Student Trustees' advisory votes, and Trustee Donna Miller abstaining from the vote.**

FINANCE & FACILITIES:

Item 3.a: Upon clarification on a purchase order, it was moved by Trustee Leonard Lahtinen and seconded by Trustee Michael Matsuda that the Board ratify purchase order numbers P0063554 - P0066210 through July 6, 2009, totaling \$3,793,950.81, and check numbers C0025314 - C0025521, totaling \$4,189,577.40; check numbers F0114466 - F0116043, totaling \$256,893.67; check numbers 88346931 - 88348705, totaling \$10,941,740.22; and check numbers V0030918 - V0030922, totaling \$4,489.05; and check numbers 70029759 - 70030041, totaling \$20,619.00 , through June 30, 2009. **Motion carried, including the Student Trustees' advisory votes.**

Item 3.b: By the block vote, authorization was granted to extend the agreement with Vavrinek, Trine, Day & Co. for the District's 2009-10 and 2010-11 audits. The annual fees are \$113,835. This fee is exclusive of any additional accounting services desired by the District or any additional audit requirements resulting from changes in the colleges' reporting format or audit requirements as stated in the "California Community Colleges' Contracted District Audit Manual" issued by the State Chancellor's Office. Additional accounting services (special projects) will be billed at the hourly rates as outlined in the proposal.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.

Item 3.c: Authorization was granted to participate in the cooperative bids with California Multiple Award Schedules Agreements with Allsteel #21582202, Steelcase #07200478, General Services Administration with Davis #GS-28F-2110D, Versteel #GS-28F-0008S,

#GS-28F-0009S, Peter Pepper Products #GS-07F-0323N, West Coast Industries #GS-28F-0022R, #GS-28F-0023R, Sit Onit Seating #GS-29F-0295H, and US Communities Virco #0844685. The procurement division will bill for the use of the contracts 1.21% of the total value of each purchase order for administrative fees. The contracts will expire June 30, 2012.

Further authorization was granted for the District Director, Purchasing, to execute the agreements on behalf of the District.

Item 3.d: Upon clarification on security services, it was moved by Trustee Leonard Lahtinen and seconded by Trustee Michael Matsuda that the Board grant retroactive authorization to renew the agreement with SECURTEC, Inc., for patrol and parking enforcement services at the Anaheim Campus, beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2010, at a fixed monthly fee of \$2,276, and a not-to-exceed annual amount of \$27,312. Any additional services required such as, but not limited to emergency call-outs, will be charged at 4-hour increments at \$30 per hour. The agreement may be terminated with or without cause at any time upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.
Motion carried, including the Student Trustees' advisory votes.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.

Item 3.e: By the block vote, authorization was granted to file the Notice of Completion of Work for the Design and Construction of Energy Efficient Lighting Retrofits, Sump Pump Replacements, and Steam System Repairs at Fullerton College, with ACCO Engineered Systems, and release the retention payment when due.

Item 3.f: By the block vote, authorization was granted to file the Notice of Completion of Work for PW 2008-001, Library Learning Resource Center Dome Replacement Project at Fullerton College, with GTA Construction, Inc., and release the retention payment when due.

Item 3.g: By the block vote, retroactive authorization was granted to amend the agreement with MTGL, Inc., and increase the contract amount by \$150,000 from \$280,000 to \$430,000 per year for materials inspection and testing laboratory services for various projects in the District beginning June 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2010.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute the amendment to the agreement on behalf of the District.

Item 3.h: By the block vote, retroactive authorization was granted to amend the agreements with tBP/Architecture and extend the term of the agreements for the Cypress College Piazza Infrastructure Repair and the School of Continuing Education Projects from January 1, 2009, through March 31, 2010.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to sign the amendment to the agreements on behalf of the District.

Item 3.i: By the block vote, the Board adopted Resolution No. 09-10/02 for the Approval of Change Order as an Amendment to the Existing Contract with Williams Scotsman, Inc., for RFP 2007-28, Fullerton College, Relocatable Buildings for the South Science Project, and approve the award of additional work totaling \$26,362.69, without competitively bidding such work.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute all agreements and complete all necessary documents for the additional work.

Item 3.j: By the block vote, the Board ratified the current change orders for the public works projects listed per the Change Order Request, with a total of \$71,159.01.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, to execute each contractor agreement on behalf of the District.

INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES

Item 4.a: Trustee Leonard Lahtinen commended the District on its positive relationships with other local educational institutions. It was moved by Trustee Leonard Lahtinen and seconded by Trustee Michael Matsuda that the Board grant retroactive authorization was granted to enter into subcontract agreements with, and provide funding to, Anaheim Union High School District in the amount of \$15,300, Brea Olinda Unified School District in the amount of \$5,000, Los Alamitos Unified School District in the amount of \$6,600, Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District in the amount of \$10,500, and North Orange County Regional Occupational Program in the amount of \$16,800 from the Cypress College and Fullerton College Tech Prep Education Project Grant for the period of July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010. All agreements are contingent upon the approval, receipt of funds from, and obligation of funds by, the California Community College Chancellor's Office to the North Orange County Community College District. **Motion carried, including the Student Trustees' advisory votes.**

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance and Facilities, or the District Director, Fiscal Affairs, to execute any agreements and related documents and any amendments to modify the agreements on behalf of the District.

Item 4.b: It was moved by Trustee Molly McClanahan and seconded by Jeff Brown that the Board grant authorization to enter into an agreement with Diana C. Stroud, Inc. for the School of Continuing Education's Boeing Company Leadership Training Program, in conjunction with the Center for Applied Competitive Technologies grant activities, for an amount not to exceed \$289,000 for the period of July 29, 2009, through June 30, 2010, to deliver leadership training to Boeing Company employees. This agreement is contingent upon the approval, receipt of funds from, and obligation of funds by, the Boeing Company to the North Orange County Community College District. **Motion carried, including the Student Trustees' advisory votes, and Trustee Barbara Dunsheath abstaining from the vote.**

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, the District Director, Fiscal Affairs, or the District Director, Purchasing, to execute any agreements and related documents and any amendments to modify the agreements on behalf of the District.

Item 4.c: By the block vote, authorization was granted to amend the subcontract agreement with California State University, Long Beach for the Cypress College Cost Reduction and Access Act Grant to provide additional funding to California State University, Long Beach in the amount of \$3,700 for the period of June 1, 2009, through July 31, 2009. This agreement is contingent upon the approval, receipt of funds from, and obligation of funds by, the Department of Education to the North Orange County Community College District.

Further authorization was granted for the Vice Chancellor, Finance and Facilities, or the District Director, Fiscal Affairs, to execute any agreements and related documents and any amendments to modify the agreements on behalf of the District.

Item 4.d: Upon discussion of specific activities and the funding used for such activities, it was moved by Trustee Barbara Dunsheath and seconded by Trustee Michael Matsuda that the Board grant authorization for the Fullerton College International Student Center to sponsor a variety of field trips and activities throughout the fall 2009 semester at a cost not to exceed \$7,000 to support the success of new international students as they acclimate to Southern California and Fullerton College. **Motion carried, including the Student Trustees' advisory votes.**

Item 5.e: It was moved by Trustee Leonard Lahtinen and seconded by Trustee M. Tony Ontiveros to approve the negotiated three-year successor agreement between Adjunct Faculty United/AFT/AFL-CIO Local 6106 and the District, effective July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2012, inclusive of all terms and conditions specified in the written Settlement Agreement between Adjunct Faculty United and the District, and inclusive of the following provisions with respect to salary and benefits:

1. There will be no increase in the Adjunct Faculty Salary Schedule for the 2008 2009 fiscal year.
2. There will be no increase in the medical premium reimbursement benefit amount for the 2008-2009 fiscal year.
3. The hourly rates for the two salary steps in Column II of *Schedule C* of the Adjunct Faculty Salary Schedule will be adjusted as follows, effective September 8, 2009:
 - a. The hourly rate for Column II, Step 0 will be adjusted by fifty-two cents, from \$42.93 to \$43.45;
 - b. The hourly rate for Column II, Step 1 will be adjusted by fifty-four cents, from \$44.65 to \$45.19.
