Education Code Section 79020;
Title 5, Section 5700, et seq., Section 58142

- 1.0 The academic year consists of 175 days of instruction.
- 2.0 Flexible days are considered part of the 175 days of instruction.
- 3.0 Statutory holidays are observed on the dates noted, or on alternate dates in accordance with Education Code 79020, and include:
 - 3.1 New Year's Day (January 1)
 - 3.2 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (Third Monday in January)
 - 3.3 Lincoln Day (February 12)
 - 3.4 Washington Day (Third Monday in February)
 - 3.5 Memorial Day (Last Monday in May)
 - 3.6 Independence Day (July 4)
 - 3.7 Labor Day (First Monday in September)
 - 3.8 Veterans' Day (November 11)
 - 3.9 Thanksgiving Day (Fourth Thursday in November)
 - 3.10 Christmas Day (December 25)
- 4.0 The Board of Trustees may declare other days to be holidays and close the colleges and offices when good reason exists.
