1.0 The campus articulation officer shall:

- 1.1 Serve as a member on the Campus Curriculum Committee and the District Curriculum Coordinating Committee.
- 1.2 Serve as a resource to faculty in the curriculum development process.
- 1.3 Submit annual curriculum changes to the University of California and California State University systems for acceptance of transfer credit.
- 1.4 Submit new and revised course outlines to University of California and California State University systems for inclusion into general education agreements.
- 1.5 Initiate and maintain articulation agreements with public and independent baccalaureate-level institutions within and outside the State of California as appropriate and advantageous to the campus.
- 1.6 Submit new and revised course outlines to baccalaureate-level institutions for course-to-course articulation.
