

## **AP 4010 Academic Calendar**

Reference:

**Education Code Section 79020;  
Title 5 Sections 5700 et seq. and Section 58142**

- 1.0 The academic year consists of 177 days of instruction.
- 2.0 Flexible days are considered part of the 177 days of instruction.
- 3.0 Statutory holidays are observed on the dates noted, or on alternate dates in accordance with Education Code Section 79020, and include:
  - 3.1 New Year's Day (January 1)
  - 3.2 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (Third Monday in January)
  - 3.3 Lincoln Day (February 12)
  - 3.4 President's Day (Third Monday in February)
  - 3.5 Farmworkers Day (March 31)
  - 3.6 Memorial Day (Last Monday in May)
  - 3.7 Juneteenth (June 19)
  - 3.8 Independence Day (July 4)
  - 3.9 Labor Day (First Monday in September)
  - 3.10 Veterans' Day (November 11)
  - 3.11 Thanksgiving Day (Fourth Thursday in November)
  - 3.12 Christmas Day (December 25)
- 4.0 The Board of Trustees may declare other days to be holidays and close the colleges and offices when good reason exists.
