

AP 4027 Philosophy and Criteria for Continuing Education

Reference:

**Education Code Sections 84757, 8500, 8510, 8530-8538
Title 5 Section 55154**

1.0 To earn a high school diploma, a student must:

- 1.1 Satisfactorily complete 160 credits in the Board-approved curriculum.
- 1.2 Receive a minimum passing grade in each course taken.
- 1.3 Demonstrate academic competencies in the areas of reading, English language, composition, and mathematics.

2.0 For a career and technical education certificate, a student must:

- 2.1 Complete all course and program requirements as stated within the Board-approved curriculum.
- 2.2 Receive a passing grade based on demonstrated competencies.
