

BP 5050 Student Success and Support Program

- 1.0 The District shall maintain a Student Success and Support Program to increase student access and success by providing core matriculation services including orientation, assessment and placement, counseling, advising, and other educational planning services necessary to assist students in achieving their educational goal.
- 2.0 The District shall also maintain Mathematics, Engineering, Science Achievement (MESA) programs to enhance opportunities for students in the science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields and to help improve diversity in the pool of candidates pursuing baccalaureate degrees in STEM majors.
- 3.0 The Chancellor shall establish procedures to ensure that implementation of the Student Success and Support Program and MESA programs comply with the requirements of Title 5.
