Noncredit Course Repeatability

B. Courserdog: Feedback and next steps toward approval of purchase

The committee reviewed positive feedback from recent CourseDog demos and discussed the potential adoption of CourseDog for curriculum and scheduling. Concerns were raised about the vendor not being part of the CollegeBuys program and the integration with eLumen, with a proposed soft launch in Spring 2026 and full launch in Fall 2026. There was discussion to bring forward a proposal for district-wide funding to the District Technology Committee.
