- Developing educational strategies that reinforce the Buen Cypress brand identity

- Centralizing services that support the education and wellbeing of students.
- Embracing 106 years of the collegiate history and alumni
- Strengthening the success of all existing programs while considering the potential growth of fields such as STEM

- Addressing accessibility across campus
- Multicultural center and safe spaces for undocumented students and students of color (e.g., Dream Center, D/I groups, LGBTQ)
- Increasing defensible spaces throughout the campus
- Developing a sense of belonging through intentional spaces
- Embedded tutoring inside and outside of the classroom (Guided Pathways)
- Sustainable practices throughout the campus experience
- Seamless process from district high schools to FC
- Enhancing campus dining experience

NORTH ORANGE CONTINUING EDUCATION (NOCE)

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EDUCATIONAL MASTER PLAN THEMES NOCE

- Developing a comparable and continuous educational experience at each center
- Identifying strategies to maximize the institutional presence of NOCE resources for the local community
- Improving technological capacities to monitor student success and career opportunities within the identified industry sectors

FACILITIES MASTER PLAN THEMES NOCE

- Mobility: Upper Parking Deck- Repair and Reimagine?
- Mobility: Improve Wayfinding; Reorganization of Traffic, Access and Drop-off
- Student Life: Varied Range and Scales of Student Services
- Identity: Institutional Identity

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS & THEMES NOCE

- Provide better access to technology and practical learning environments for programs such as nursing and pharmacy
- The Wilshire Center at Fullerton College does not have enough student parking, gathering spaces, and dining amenities.
- Better spaces for parents and their children at the Anaheim Campus to play both indoors and outdoors while students are in their program or studying.
- Security concerns: access and physical safety throughout the campus sites.
- Need for a full-service library and with research resources at the Anaheim campus.
- As the expansion occurs at Cypress College, a connection to the main campus hub will be important so students at the Center feel integrated.
- Finding ways to serve evening students in the same manner as the day time students.

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS & THEMES NOCE

- Enhanced branding that distinguishes campus from District.
- Standardizing the orientation process
- Development of marketing materials with multilingual awareness
- Simulation labs and flexible spaces for programs (e.g., PharmTech, Medical Assistant program)
- Access to food options (during all class hours)
- Curriculum development for staff to better service students (IBEST example)
- Enhanced student parking (Wilsheire)
- Access to flexible counseling and office spaces for faculty and staff

DISTRICT MEETINGS

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Themes and Considerations

- Developing a uniform communications platform (e.g., Emergency systems, banner, EMS, help desk, directory, SSO).
- Coordinated job placement events to prevent duplication or overlap
- Alumni and former student data tracking
- Curriculum inventory to enhance DegreeWorks
- Large multipurpose facility for events
