PRIMARY PURPOSE

This position is responsible for performing skilled locksmithing work in the repair and maintenance of facilities locking systems including software, locks and hardware on door closures and lockers.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Examples of essential functions are interpreted as being descriptive and not restrictive in nature.

Assures the security and safety of campus equipment and facilities through proper maintenance of door locks, Frequency Operated Button (Fob), hardware, software and closures. Checks, installs, diagnoses and repairs locks, circuit boards, card readers, reader interface, power supplies, transformers,; disassembles locks to determine source of problems; lubricates, repairs or replaces parts as necessary and reassemble. Installs and adjusts doors, closures, panic hardware and various types of commercial hardware. Selects, installs, calibrates, and maintains various electronic entry and locking software systems, card readers, doors, storefront doors, slider doors, plank doors, solid doors, hollow doors, automatic operator, motor clutch assemblies, pulleys, motors, gearboxes, for effective safety solutions to fulfill the requirements for Americans with Disabilities regulations, and effective safety measures. Checks facilities for broken fobs, locks, loose bolts, broken catches and metal damage; assists in opening locks when keys cannot be located. Performs master-keying duties; creates new or duplicate keys, using appropriate technology and codes as required; performs master-key duties; maintains accurate records of key to lock location. Replaces or repairs electrical components, hardware, and software in compliance with applicable codes and regulations; meets with vendors and contractors regarding the repair and replacement of hardware. Performs and assists in performing other related skills maintenance duties as assigned including elevators; assists or performs carpentry duties in the installation of new doors and hinges. Prepares requisitions and orders required parts and materials. Learns and applies emerging technologies and advances as necessary to perform duties in an efficient, organized, and timely manner. Participate in District/College efforts to increase the diversity of faculty and staff and to address student achievement gaps; active assistance in the creation of a welcoming and inclusive work and educational environment; attend and participate in diversity, equity and inclusion trainings and events. 11.
