PRIMARY PURPOSE

This position is responsible for assisting in the performance of semi-skilled to skilled maintenance work on buildings, systems and related equipment.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Performs a variety of building maintenance and repair work utilizing the basic trades. 1. Assists in the maintenance of facilities; repairs offices, hallways, restrooms, classrooms, and building exteriors: repairs and installs various dispensers; installs chalkboards, bulletin boards. dispensers, pencil sharpeners, signs and other equipment as assigned. Operates a variety of maintenance tools and equipment including trucks, manual and electrical tools; may operate a forklift as required. Reports facilities and equipment malfunctions to appropriate personnel. 4. Assists skilled-trades personnel to complete activities and tasks (e.g., electrical, carpentry, plumbing, painting and locksmith duties). Maintains a variety of records related to labor, materials and work orders. Orders supplies and materials from various vendors according to established procedures. Maintains storage areas in clean and orderly condition. Learns and applies emerging technologies and advances as necessary to perform duties in an efficient, organized, and timely manner. Participate in District/College efforts to increase the diversity of faculty and staff and to address student achievement gaps; active assistance in the creation of a welcoming and inclusive work and educational environment; attend and participate in diversity, equity and inclusion trainings and events. Performs related duties as assigned.
