

AP 4070 Course Auditing and Auditing Fees

Reference:

Education Code Section 76370

- 1.0 The Board of Trustees may authorize a person to audit a community college course and may charge that person a fee pursuant to the Education Code.
 - 1.1 Students in good standing may audit a course only if they are ineligible to take the course for credit.
 - 1.2 The fee for auditing college credit courses shall be no more than \$15 per unit. Students enrolled in classes to receive credit for ten (10) or more semester credit units shall not be charged a fee to audit three or fewer units per semester.
 - 1.3 The Board of Trustees shall proportionately adjust the amount of the fee for term lengths based on a quarter system or other alternative system approved, and shall also proportionately adjust the amount of the fee for summer sessions, intersessions, and other short-term courses.
 - 1.4 No student auditing a course shall be permitted to change their enrollment to receive credit for the course.
 - 1.5 Priority in class enrollment shall be given to students enrolled in the course for credit toward a degree or certificate.
 - 1.6 Information regarding auditing shall be made available to students in the college catalog.
