BP 4235 Credit for Prior Learning

Reference:

Title 5 Section 55050

1.0 The Board of Trustees shall adopt and publish regulations pertaining to credit for prior learning in accordance with the provisions of Section 55050. The Board of Trustees may grant credit to any student who passes or completes an assessment approved by discipline faculty and other proper authorities. Procedures for students to attain credit for prior learning shall include, but not be limited to, credit by examination, evaluation of Joint Services Transcripts, evaluation of student-created portfolios, evaluation of industry-recognized credential documentation, and standardized exams. The Chancellor, in consultation with the faculty, as stated in BP/AP2510, Participation in Local Decision-making, shall establish administrative procedures to implement this policy.
