

BP 5015 Residence Determination

Reference:

**Education Code Sections 68040; 76140;
Title 5, Sections 54000, et seq.**

- 1.0 Students shall be classified at the time of each application for admission or registration as a resident or nonresident student.
- 2.0 A resident is any person who has been a bona fide resident of California for at least one year on the residence determination date. The residence determination date shall be the day immediately preceding the first day of a semester or summer session for which the student applies to attend.
- 3.0 Residence classification shall be made for each student at the time applications for admission are accepted or registration occurs and whenever a student has not been in attendance for more than one semester. A student previously classified as a nonresident may be reclassified as of any residence determination date.
- 4.0 The Chancellor shall enact procedures to assure that residence determinations are made in accordance with Education Code and Title 5 regulations.
