At each open forum, finalists will present a brief statement and answer questions from students, faculty, staff, and community members. Comment forms will also be available at the forums and will be reviewed by the NOCCCD Board of Trustees.

The Board of Trustees will interview the four finalists on May 13. Plans are to announce the new Chancellor by the end of May, with a start date of July 1.

Dr. Ned Doffoney retired as Chancellor of the NOCCCD on February 28. Among his many accomplishments during his seven-year tenure, Dr. Doffoney led the development of the District-wide Master Plan, re-accreditation of Cypress College and Fullerton College, and the first accreditation for the School of Continuing Education. He was also instrumental in expanding programs and facilities throughout the District, including passage of the Measure J facilities bond measure, in order to prepare a 21<sup>st</sup> century workforce.
