NOCCCD Chancellor Search Extended

Anaheim, Calif. – After interviewing two candidates for the open Chancellor position, the North Orange County Community College District (NOCCCD) Board of Trustees has decided to extend its search. Interim Chancellor Fred Williams will continue in that role until the permanent Chancellor position is satisfactorily filled.

“We had two very talented candidates as finalists for the position,” said Board of Trustees President M. Tony Ontiveros, “but this position is critical for the success of our campuses and community, and we need to ensure that we have the perfect fit. So we will keep looking until we find the right person.”

A nation-wide search for a permanent Chancellor will soon begin, with an anticipated start date of July 1, 2016.
