As a follow-up to the committee's suggestion made at the November 19, 2021 DCCC meeting, David Soto has reached out to our District Director, Research, Planning, and Data Management, Gabrielle Stanco to coordinate a survey tool to garner student feedback on proposed acronym changes to transfer degrees in light of the new UCTP product. Dr. Stanco recommended developing a student focus group comprised of 3-5 students from Fullerton, Cypress and NOCE. The committee agreed to create the focus group. David and Gabrielle will coordinate with Campus Student Life Directors to invite students. Committee will be updated once feedback has been received.
