A. District Approval Process AP 4020 Review

Chairs agreed to continue discussion through campus curriculum committees. Facilitated discussion with disciplined faculty will continue with the goal to finalize edits by Fall 2022 for review at DCCC.

B. Revision BP 4100/AP 4100 Language (to allow for acceptance of prior degrees to waive local GE requirements and other edits)

Chairs have requested a Microsoft Word version of these document for reviewing purposes to bring up for review at the April DCCC.

C. AB 705

Cypress College Vice President of Instruction (CC VPI) informed committee of efforts taken by disciplined faculty in Math to continue their work in phasing out remedial Math courses. As of Fall 2022 Cypress College Math Department will not be offering a below level Math course. The goal will continue to be developing transfer level courses in union with eliminating all below level Math courses.

D. AB 111

AB 111 – Common Course Numbering is a State initiative geared toward adopting common course numbers for all schools. Cypress and Fullerton are awaiting official decision from the State to be able to organize the effort to align. On the technical side, Common Course numbers will be housed in Banner under the “CAN” field. Upon agreement of common course numbers, Cypress and Fullerton will begin the work of aligning course numbers.

E. Clarification of State Approval Timelines, Banner Entry Timelines, and Fall 2022 Schedules

In light of new personnel replacing others and continuous needs for technical support, a clarification discussion was had to help contextualize efforts made in addressing matters pertaining to curricular approvals and technical inputting timelines. Support systems are currently being established in this time of transition and training continues to be offered to newly placed staff members. Timelines are being developed, and updates will continue to be made to DCCC going forward. CC and FC Schedules are proposed to be to be released in early April 2022 for the Summer Term.
