

Native Art Contest




ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS!

Native Art Contest

DESCRIPTION: This is an open call to Fullerton College, Cypress College, and North Orange Continuing Education students to submit artwork representing Native American Indian heritage or culture for the Native American Faculty and Staff Alliance logo development. Selected artwork of contest winner and honorable mentions will be on digital display in Fall 2021; entries may also be featured in physical displays in 2021-2022 or after campuses reopen. The finalists and winner will be invited to a virtual reception in Spring 2021.

Cash prizes will be awarded (One prize of \$100 for first place, two \$50 awards for honorable mentions). All work will be juried by members of the Native American Faculty and Staff Alliance (NAFSA).

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be submitted by 10 p.m. on **May 5, 2021** to NativeArtContest@nocccd.edu. No late entries will be accepted.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Original work by a currently enrolled (or former student) of Cypress College, Fullerton College or North Orange Continuing Education is eligible. Student warrants each entry is their own, original work.
- All entries must be 2-D and fit the following requirements for contest consideration:
 - Art reflects Native American Indian heritage or culture
 - Color: Black and white version, designed to work on both a white and black background. Artist can also specify a CMYK 1-color version if desired.
 - Scalable Vector (Illustrator) image submitted as high resolution PDF or EPS format (300 dpi)
 - Completely fill out one form for each entry. No submission fee for entry.

Native American Faculty & Staff Alliance (NAFSA)

AWARDS: Juries Choice (\$100 First Place Winner and two \$50 Honorable Mention awards); totaling \$200 in cash awards. Quality, pertinence to Native American Indian heritage or culture, creativity of the work submitted, and usability for NAFSA logo development are the primary considerations in determining who receives the awards. Students whose work is selected as finalists will be notified by email in May 2021. Students who become finalists agree to allow the District to announce or publish their name and likeness in its events, videos, social media, press release, print or other publications.

OWNERSHIP: Students who enter the contest acknowledge and agree that their work submitted may become or be incorporated into a logo mark, word mark, or logo composite mark of the District's Native American Faculty and Staff Alliance (NAFSA). Winning student freely gives the artwork to the District and its Colleges, and agrees to its exclusive use by the District and its Colleges, including the right to modify, reproduce, and use the artwork in communications, social media, logos, word marks, logo composites, branding items, or other uses as seen fit by the District and/or Colleges. Student forfeits all rights to the submitted artwork, including trademark, copyright, reproduction.

ENTRY AGREEMENT: Along with your digital file, please also provide: Your Name; Phone; E-mail; Artwork Title; Year of Artwork; and Contest rules statement. If you have a tribal membership or affiliation, please indicate which tribe(s). Note: Tribal membership or affiliation is not required to enter the contest. Include this statement in your email contest submission(s): "By submitting an entry into the Native Art Contest, I verify I have read all rules, terms and conditions for the contest included on the art contest flier. I understand and agree to them."
