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Stephen T. Blount Elected as NOCCCD's Area 3 Trustee

Anaheim, Calif. – The Orange County Registrar of Voters has officially certified Mr. Stephen T. Blount as the winner of the February 9 Trustee Area 3 election. His term runs through November 2018, and the North Orange County Community College District (NOCCCD) Board of Trustees will seat him at their March 8 Board Meeting. Blount assumes the seat of Donna Miller, who resigned on June 30, 2015.

He currently serves on the Cypress School District Board of Trustees until his March 8 seating with NOCCCD, and is a member of numerous community organizations.
