 - Provide proof of experience of at least 3 direct-buried piping projects that required trenching in an active and occupied campus or campus-like setting (CSU, UC, equivalent private University, public college campus or multi-building industrial complex with a centralized heating plant). At least one of the three projects must be the demolition, removal and replacement of the existing piping system and have a minimum constructed value of \$300 thousand dollars. The total aggregate value of all three projects combined shall be at least \$800 thousand dollars.
 - 2. Contractor must demonstrate construction experience with:
 - a. Open trenchwork in occupied public spaces.
 - b. Direct-buried pressurized mechanical hydronic systems using plastic or steel piping for chilled water and/or heating hot water piping components.
 - c. General building piping installation.
 - 3. Work Plans. Provide one sample of the construction scheduled that was used and maintained for a direct-buried pressurized pipe project completed in the last seven years with owner reference contact information.
- B. Contractor must have constructed all the submitted projects in the State of California, and one must have been a public works project. References for these projects must be current and verifiable.
- C. Listed projects must have been managed and constructed under the business name submitted. Projects completed by employees for former employers are not acceptable.
- D. Submit a Project Data Sheet for each project offered as evidence of direct-buried pressurized pipe experience and general building contractor experience.
- E. If the general contractor holds the appropriate license, and will self-perform the work, the general contractor shall complete this prequalification questionnaire in lieu of a sub-contractor.
