

SUPPLEMENTARY CONDITIONS

Article 8.2.2. Performance During Working Hours:

8.2.2. Where a single shift is worked, eight (8) consecutive hours with applicable prevailing wage rate(s) applied. The shift will be determined by the project manager after project award.

Article 8.2.2. Performance During Working Hours

8.2.2 Forty (40) hours shall constitute a work week at the applicable prevailing wage rate(s) with scheduling provided by the project manager after award.

Article 8.4.1 Liquidated damages – Contractor will be liable to District for liquidated damages pursuant to Article 8.4 for each calendar day of delay in the amount of **\$500**.

ARTICLE 11 – INSURANCE and BONDS

Article 11.10 Performance and Payment Bonds – The number of executed copies of the Performance Bond and the Payment Bond required is three (3).

CLOSE OUT DOCUMENT

All project closeout documentation must be complete and submitted with final payment application. Failure to do so will delay final payment until all completed documents have been received and verified.

REQUEST FOR SUBSTITUTION

Any request for substitution shall be submitted to the District for review by April 7, 2017.

BID OPTIONS/ ALTERNATES

Each bidder must provide a price for Base Bid Option A and Base Bid Option B as set forth in the Bid Form. Failure to provide pricing for both options will render the bid non-responsive. The District will evaluate the bids and prices for both options using the “blind bid” method under Public Contract Code section 20103.8(d) where the identities of the bidders or proposed subcontractors or suppliers are not revealed. The District will award one contract for the entire project to the bidder that provides the lowest price for Base Bid Option A or Base Bid Option B that the District decides, in its sole discretion, will be in the best interest and most advantageous to the District. The District's decision to determine the lowest responsive responsible bidder for Base Bid Option A or Base Bid Option B will be made prior to the identities of the bidders being revealed to District staff and consultants who will be evaluating all bids and who will not be present at the location bids are opened.
